2019 MVS SCHOLARSHIPS

Applications for the 2019 Most Valuable Student contest are now open: https://www.elks.org/scholars/scholarships/MVS.cfm

Eligibility:

Current high school seniors, or the equivalent, who are citizens of the United States are eligible to apply.

Applicants need not be related to a member of the Elks.

High school graduates are not eligible to apply.

Applicants must be citizens of the United States on the date their applications are signed; permanent legal resident status does not qualify.

Applications are due online by November 15, 2018. Paper copies will be collected at Hoboken High School on the same deadline for the Eddie Chuis scholarships.

The top 20 MVS finalists will attend the Most Valuable Student Leadership Weekend from April 11-14, 2019, in Chicago to interview for the top awards of \$50,000, \$40,000 and \$30,000. The remaining 14 finalists will receive \$20,000 each.

480 other deserving national finalists will receive \$4,000 scholarships to support their college education.


